Safety Guidelines for use of Club Boats

Please follow these guidelines when using any North Shore Yacht Club-owned sailboat or kayak

- All members must be certified by NSYC sailing instructors prior to using the club sailboats and NSYC officer prior to using the club kayaks.
- Members who use the club boats are responsible for any damage they incur to the boat. Report any pre-existing damage prior to using a club boat.
- Do not use club boats in heavy surf or high wind conditions.
- Do not sail club boats alone. For safety reasons, we require at least two boats to be on the water and sailing/paddling together at all times using the “buddy system”.
- All people on the boat must wear zipped and/or buckled US Coast Guard Approved Type III Personal Flotation Devices at all times while using the boat (from shore to shore).
- No club boats can be taken out without the Park District staff being made aware that you are out.
- Return all club boats to their storage space after use. Use the club dolly to take boat out of water. Do not drag boats on the sand. Rinse and clean all boats and equipment to remove sand and debris. Properly stow sails, spars, rudders, tillers, main sheets, and any additional club-owned equipment when you are done with it. Lock the boats and put the key away after use.
- Members who do not comply have violated these safety guidelines and may lose membership privileges depending upon the severity and details of the situation.
